Proposed Council Tax Precept 2018/19

At the meeting of the Police and Crime Panel held on Friday 2nd February 2018, Members voted unanimously with the recommendation within the report, namely:

'To consider a proposed annual increase in Council Tax for 2018/19 equivalent to £12.00 for a Band D property (a 7.6% increase) to £170.16. For Band A properties this equates to an annual increase of £8.00, to £113.44 and for Band B properties an increase of £9.33, to £132.35'.

Please find below the full list of resolutions from the minutes for completeness.

RESOLVED - That Members of the Police and Crime Panel:-

- i) Voted unanimously on the recommendation within the report and agreed the proposed annual increase in Council Tax for 2018/19 of £12 for a Band D property (a 7.6% increase) to £170.16. For Band A properties this equated to an annual increase of £8.00, to £113.44 and for Band B properties an increase of £9.33, to £132.35 be approved.
- ii) Noted that the Commissioner had agreed to provide Members with a list of the proposed areas where savings would be made by the Force in 2018/19.
- iii) Noted that the Commissioner would try to accommodate Members' request for a Budget Working Group.
