### **Proposed Council Tax Precept 2020/21**

At the meeting of the Police and Crime Panel held on Thursday 6th February 2020, Members voted to support the Council Tax Precept for 2020/21 and the minute from the meeting is as follows:

A report of the Chief Finance and Commissioning Officer, OPCC was presented to notify the Police and Crime Panel of the South Yorkshire Police and Crime Commissioner's proposed Council Tax precept for 2020/21.

The Chair, Councillor Nevetton moved to accept the proposed increase in Council Tax precept for 2020/21 equivalent to 2% and this was seconded by the Vice-Chair, Councillor Sansome.

A recorded vote was taken as follows:-

For accepting the proposed increase in Council Tax precept for 2020/21 - (9) Councillors Nevetton, Sansome, Grocutt, Garbutt, Mitchell, Short, Wilkinson, Professor James and Mr Carter.

Against the proposed increase (1) Councillor Otten and abstained (0).

The proposal was approved.

RESOLVED – That Members of the Police and Crime Panel voted to accept the proposed annual increase in Council Tax precept for 2020/21 equivalent to 2%. This would be equivalent to a £3.88 increase for a Band D property to £198.04 for the year. For Band A properties this equated to an annual increase of £2.59 and £3.02 for Band B properties be approved.
