The total number of casualties for 2018-19 was 57, an increase of 19 from 2017-18. The attached provides a breakdown along with the information overleaf, which includes 7 incidents that resulted in a total of 20 casualties. There is clear evidence that casualties tend to be below the age of 65 whilst fatalities are mainly linked to older people. (Please refer to the PowerPoint document attached).
