Update from DCFO Kirby & GMB S Rowland

Although no FRS received an 'Outstanding' judgement in this area, a number of services received positive comments on their risk management work. These include Bedforedshire, Royal Berkshire, Merseyside and Lincolnshire, Cleveland also received positive comments in their HMICFRS inspection report and their CFO is the lead for the NFCC Risk Management Project.

This area of good practice is included on the Service Improvement Plan and has been assigned to our Strategy Manager to investigate further.

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
